

2026 Consecration Schedule



- **January 2, 5-9** (1 meal per day after 3pm, Prayer & Scripture, and 30min of “PRA”)
- **January 12-16** (Caloric Constriction, Prayer & Scripture, and 30min of “PRA”)
- **January 20-23** (Personal Sacrifice, Prayer & Scripture, and 30min of “PRA”)
- **January 26-27** (43hr. “*Absolute Fast*,” Prayer & Scripture, and 30min of “PRA”)

Note: We are drinking water only for the entire month. However, you can drink the water whenever you'd like; accept during the Absolute Fast. The “Caloric Constriction” is gender specific. Men are allowed 2,000 calories per day and women are allowed 1,500. The daily “PRA” stands for “Promise Readiness Activity.” This is and can be any activity that helps make you ready for what you are believing God for. Example: If you are believing for a new job, develop a new marketable skill (like AI Prompting). Also, we are abstaining from ALL forms of social media for the entire month. Lastly, we are limiting our TV watching on our designated consecration days because we want to hear from God.

Pray this prayer at 9am, 12noon, and 3pm.

Dear heavenly Father, I **thank you** for your loving kindness and your tender mercies. I thank you for every **way** you have made and every **door** you have opened. God, I thank you today for how you have covered me all the days of my life. You have **stayed** the hand of death, and I'm grateful. Right now, I **praise** you for your continued grace and endless love that directs me.

Now, God, I ask that you look on True Covenant Church. Make us one. **Bind** us together with cords that cannot be **broken**. Show us your power. **Reveal** your glory and perform in us everything you **Promised**. Help us to become the “**Latter Day**” Church. That Church that will both speak and live in accordance with your Word and your Will. Lord, **empower** us to walk out the purpose you have **assigned** us to. Lead us to the men and women you are drawing to our ministry. Cause “**Manifested Promises**” to **overtake** us this year and flood our lives with good works. Let every answered prayer bring glory to You and Your kingdom. **Deepen** our desire for you and **renew** our love for your things.
